Like our approach to building bikes, our company is old, yet new. The corporation was formed in 1995, but the people that make up **Independent Fabrication** have been making bike frames since 1989. As far as materials go, we again defer to history. There's a reason that so many bikes have been made from steel and steel alloys in the past: it works – very well in fact. **IF** chooses Reynolds 853 tubing, because we feel it is the best available. In addition, we seal the inside of the seat tube with J.P. Weigle's Frame Saver™ to ensure that your bike stays in top form.

Since there are so many seemingly similar steel bikes out there, we strive to differentiate our bikes through quality. We take

extra care in every aspect of manufacturing, controlling the whole process in house. We do it all with the same expert care and attention: tool and fixture-making, welding, alignment, brazing, finish work, priming and painting. If it comes from **Independent Fabrication**, you can rest assured that one of us did it.

Visually, the first things most people notice about our bikes are the incredible paint jobs. We offer an unbelievable number of "custom" paint options at no extra charge, and we can even apply whatever sick and twisted paint scheme you can come up with. Consider your bike a blank canvas.

Even underneath our pristine paint, our attention to detail is meticulous. Get out the magnifying glass and take a real close look at our welds and brazing – compare that to any other bike (and we mean ANY bike), and we're pretty sure we'll come out on top.

But in the end, it all comes down to you and your bike. Like a good dog, a bike that feels right can be your best friend – a devoted companion that can enrich your life on a daily basis. 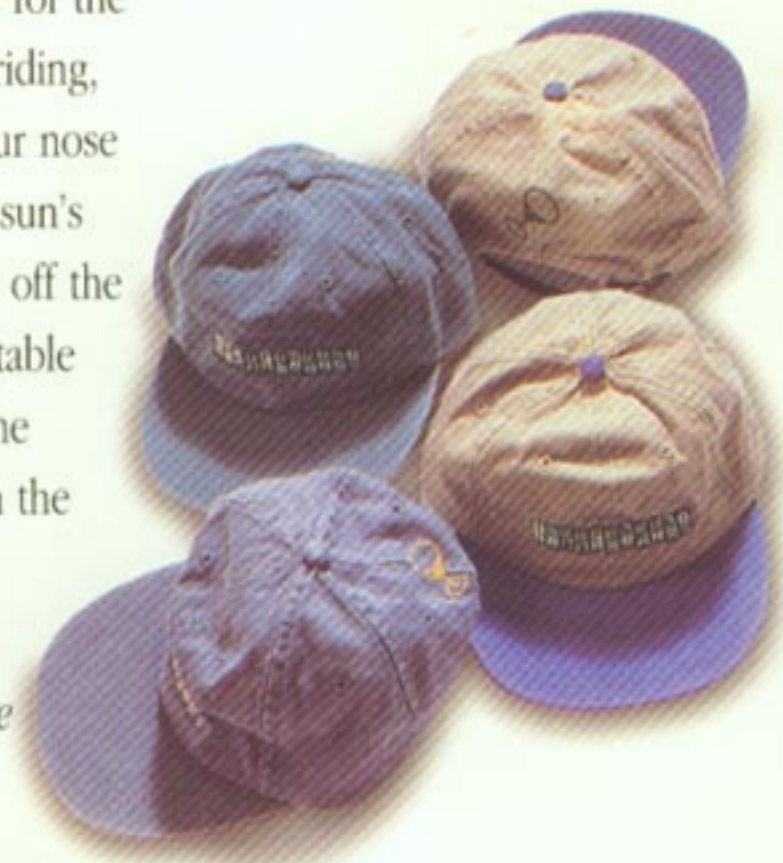
T-SHIRTS

They're simple, but still unbelievably popular. We probably sell lots of shirts because not everyone can afford one of our bikes.

CAPS

Although there's no substitute for the protection of a helmet while riding, a baseball cap helps keep your nose and scalp protected from the sun's harmful UV rays when you're off the bike. Our comfortable, adjustable cap displays the **IF** logo on the front and our martini glass on the back.

Race Puppy

Martini

SPECIAL

Not all riders fit the long top tube framesets that prevail at bike shops these days. Although a shorter stem and forward saddle position can improve bike fit for longer legged riders, a properly sized frame is the real answer. The **Special** was designed primarily with women in mind, many of whom have longer legs in proportion to their overall height, and some of whom simply prefer a more upright riding position. The **Special** has a shorter top tube, and is offered in smaller sizes than the **Deluxe**. Basically, if there's not a **Deluxe** that fits you, there's probably a **Special** that can become your favorite ride.

PLANET

Europeans have been nuts about 'cross racing since way before anyone ever heard of NORBA. Here in the States, we are just beginning to notice the sport of cyclocross, as more and more mountain bike racers are using 'cross racing to bridge the fitness gap between seasons. Although some racers use mountain bikes in cyclocross races (depending on course conditions), a full on 'cross bike is still the best choice most of the time. Aside from being lighter than an equivalent mountain bike, the more road oriented frame, drop bars, 700c wheels and mountain bike style brakes are just what the doctor ordered on any Euro style course.

Roadster

If you're like us at **Independent Fabrication**, bikes are a passion. Around town, some of the coolest bikes we see and ride are single speed "cruisers," painted in basic colors with pinstripes and fake gas tanks. Out of the passion that we at **IF** share for all things retro comes the **Roadster**. With Shimano's internal 4-speed Nexus™ hub, a single front chainring, and a stylin' flames paint job, the Roadster will tote and float you around town in style.

Crown Jewel

High performance steel alloy road bikes have a long and glorious history. In competition, steel alloy bikes are the big historical winners. This is because steel is the best represented of all available frame materials. Because we've learned from history, we introduce the **Crown Jewel**, a TIG welded high performance road bike that features a short wheel base for quick handling and a relatively slack seat tube angle for long range comfort. The **Crown Jewel** is suitable for racing or just plain having fun on the road.

Although many cyclists have more than one bicycle in their collections, there is usually one that gets the most use and is reached for first.
